For those friends that don't know...Klaus was taken to the emergency room a week ago (Monday 15th) by ambulance from out of work...

Battery of tests were done and he was diagnosed with Renal Cell Carcinoma of the right Kidney.

The tumor had grown through the wall of the kidney and into the main vein and up toward the heart and into many lymph nodes around it. He has stage 3 cancer. Without surgery, possibly 8 months to live.

With surgery, he has a 25% chance to still be here in 5 years.

We were lucky enough to find a local urologist that would do the surgery.

They performed a 7 hour surgery yesterday and have gotten the tumor out also removed his right kidney, along with the infected nodes. He is in intensive care now...still has breathing tube in, but that may come out today. As of 5:45 this a.m when I spoke to the night nurse...he did not sleep well, but sometimes that happens after surgery. He is alert and writing messages to the nurse for his needs, and stable so far....

It is still touch and go for the next few days as with any major surgery....

His spirits are high and he gave me a thumbs up and indicated he loved me last night when I told him he did super through the surgery. He will probably be in ICU for a few more days..

I have heard there are friends "pissed" cause he did not let them know....

Please don't be angry...he was in shock as we all were,and it was his way of dealing...and we only found out on Thursday about the cancer and spent all day Friday having preadmission testing...there wasn't time to notify everyone

this was totally out of the blue...no warnings at all...they thought he might have a bleeding ulcer and when tests were run found the cancer instead...

I will try to update more here as soon as I can...

if you are friends on his Facebook page or on mine, I am updating there also

I thank you all for the well wishes and prayers

7:30 PM...

Klaus may have taken another step forward tonight...They have his BP meds off again, and he is holding his own there...the have the breathing ventilator turned way down and he is breathing on his own, they are keeping it in right now , just in case and to see how he does without it...

He looked much better to me tonight, and they have drained a lot more fluid off his body with the dialysis machine and he is tolerating all of that ok. They have started him on the tube feeding again, but a lot less than before and checking every 4 hours to see if he is able to tolerate that...He is putting out the most urine per hour since his surgery, which means maybe the kidney is starting to wake up now. I spoke to him to tell him I love him just before i left and I said you can hear me right and he nodded a little bit. He is still sedated so they can start weaning him off things a bit at a time...and they increase that and the BP meds if needed..

But....I'm happy tonight...I think we are headed in the right direction...

Thank you for the support and the wishes and cards...as soon as he is awake enough I will take them to him.

I'll update again tomorrow night

I just left the hospital. he is better each day. They have taken him off all the sedation and are trying to wake him up enough to take out the breathing tube. I spoke to his DR, and he says he is not alert enough yet...maybe tomorrow, the medicine still is in his body so it takes time to get it out even though its turned off.

Klaus opened his eyes and looked at me today when I spoke to him and nodded when I asked him questions, so he is starting to come around....He has been in bed now on his back for 13 days...he NEVER sleeps on his back and when I noticed him trying to move a bit, I asked if his back hurt and he nodded yes...I'm sure it does, he has back problems already. He also nodded yes when I asked him if he was cold, so i got him a blanket

I will be up to see him again tomorrow and hopefully the news will be even better..

He is uncomfortable ...but on his way ...

5:30 a.m.

HUGE setback...

I just called the hospital and spoke to a Dr, who is taking care of Klaus now instead of a nurse...Klaus was doing so well overnight they decided to take out the breathing tube, when they did his vocal cords were so swollen they were closing up and he couldn't breath well. They had to put the breathing tube back in , and before they could do that he vomitted and some went down his air passage and into his

lungs. The Dr said there is a good chance now he will develop pneumonia. The stomach contents are acidic and now into the lungs it may cause more issues. They need to watch him closer for infection and signs for pneumonia.

He is heavily sedated again, and will be for several hours. He will have the breathing tube in again probably several more days, unless they decide to perform a tracheostomy (they talked of that before).

I am sick and at a loss this morning, he was doing so well...

Please keep praying for him

Left hospital at 5:30...

Klaus sedated again, on several antibiotics (in case of infection) and back on dialysis. The dialysis is only to clean the toxins out of his blood at this time, no fluid being removed. He nodded a little when his sisters and I were in there in response to our questions. , but they have increased the sedation tonight to let him rest more while they are doing "whatever it is they are doing"...

They have taken several cultures and have sent them out for diagnosis ...it will be a couple more days til they have the results. His Dr. said, when they took the breathing tube out, his vocal cords were so swollen , they just closed up and he could not breath, so they put the tube back in...

When we left the hospital tonight he was stabilized again..(with medication) and sleeping. I will call again in the morning to check on him and see him tomorrow night after work
